FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Vernon Susan has again brought his concern about his receipt of retirement benefits from his years of service at the Lee Mercantile Store to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Susan reports that a program of benefits was in force at one time at the Lee's Store but that said program was cancelled by the employer without notice to the employees; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe expresses its concern over these matters;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ramon Riley of the Labor Relations Office, and the Legal Department investigate and look into the allegations made by Mr. Susan and involve the Bureau of Indian Affairs where appropriate.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
