RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Council Member Herbert Tate has informed the Tribal Council that he will sponsor a Rodeo School in the immediate future; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Tate has requested use of Community Land Claim Recreation Monies for the purpose of sponsoring a Rodeo School;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes Mr. Herbert Tate to sponsor a Rodeo School for the benefit of the youth on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Council Member Herbert Tate is authorized to utilize a budgeted amount of funds from the Community Land Claims Recreation Funds for the Rodeo School.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1952, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
