FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Oney Massey have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of May 26, 27, 28, 1989; and


WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Steve Titla have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at East Fork.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Oney and Dena Ann (Johnson) Massey, sponsors, and Steve and Veronica (Burnette) Titla, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of May 26, 27, 28, 1989 at East Fork.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(f),(g)&(k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
