

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recontract the Higher Education Grant, Johnson O'Malley Supplemental Funds, Adult Vocational Training Grant, and the Adult Education Grant from the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to contract for these programs on a multi-year basis; and
- WHEREAS, the P.L. 93-638 Education Program contracts have, in the past, been successfully administered by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has authorized the Tribal Education Director to develop, plan, negotiate, and administer the contracts and/or any amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Education Director is to run concurrent with the term of a Multi-Year Contract pursuant to Tribal Resolution No. 86-408.
- WHEREAS, other 638 contracts ought also to be multi-year contracts.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Education Director is hereby authorized to plan, develop, negotiate, and administer the Grants and Education Funds and Contracts discussed herein; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and/or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman are authorized and directed to sign the contract for the following programs: (1) Higher Education; (2) Johnson O'Malley Program; (3) Adult Vocational Training; and (4) Adult Education (GED).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby approves and authorizes multi-year contracts (3 year) in the above mentioned programs; and in all 638 contracts negotiated subsequent to this date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe make all 638 contracts multi-year contracts, covering May 1, 1989 to April 30, 1992, so the term coincides with the Tribe's fiscal year which is from May to April 30, 1990.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
