

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Alvin Declay, President of the Seven Mile District has planned a trip for youth in his district and youth from the East Fork district to Phoenix, Arizona for a professional basketball game; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Declay has asked that Land Claims money set aside for each district be used for this trip in the total amount of \$1,475; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes this activity will serve the interest of its young people.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the expenditure of land claims money in the total amount of \$1,475 for the Phoenix trip is hereby authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each community fund, Seven-Mile and East Fork, will be utilized equally for this expenditure.

The foregoing resolution was on March 1, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of Nine for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984.)
