

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the 13th Annual National Indian Timber Symposium will be hosted in Phoenix, Arizona from March 28, 29, 30, 1989, by the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, on March 31, 1989, the group will visit the White Mountain Apache homeland; and

WHEREAS, on said date, March 31, 1989, the White Mountain Apache Tribe will host a luncheon for fifty to one-hundred participants;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it authorizes the slaughter of an elk from the elk population and a beef from the Tribal Herd for use at the Barbeque scheduled for 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. on March 31, 1989, to provide lunch to the participants visiting the White Mountain Apache reservation from the 13th Annual National Indian Timber Symposium.

The foregoing resolution was on March 2, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of Six for and One Against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
