

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe considers the McNary area a prime area for further development; and

WHEREAS, the housing area and houses need attention and proper administration; and

WHEREAS, Matthew Hinton has worked for the Tribe in McNary for the McNary Administration for four years in various jobs and is presently acting as the manager pending a permanent hiring; and

WHEREAS, a restructuring of program is needed and an internal promotion is justified; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes that Matthew Hinton is available and capable of managing the McNary housing administration.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Matthew Hinton is hereby hired as manager for McNary Administration.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
