

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, this resolution pertains to approval of the tribal fiscal year 1989/90 Forest Management Deduction Budget and Use Plan which is administered under authority of the Code of Federal Regulations 25, Subchapter H, Section 163 and Bureau of Indian Affairs Manual 53, Supplement 3, Section 6.6; and

WHEREAS, regulations require concurrence of the Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan by the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests Bureau approval of the tribal fiscal year 1989/90 budget in the amount of \$619,171.00.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby concurs with the proposed Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan for tribal fiscal year 1989/90 and requests Bureau approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Forest Management Deductions collected will be properly deposited and expended on items designated in the Budget and Use Plan and in accordance with 25 CFR and 53 BIAM.


FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Budget #086 is deleted in its entirety; and


FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Salaries Budget 083 are adjusted to reflect only a 6% increase where appropriate as directed by the budget guideline memorandum; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Controller and BIA Fort Apache Agency Area Forestry Director confer to assure that salaries reflected in 083 are treated the same as other tribal employees per the 01 budget directives.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and

Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
