

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has proposed, and the Tribal Council has previously approved the expansion and improvement of State Route 73 through Whiteriver; and

WHEREAS, one of the major improvements in this project is the relocation of Indian Route 55 (IR 55) in order to improve the safety of that road; and

WHEREAS, it has been proposed that IR 55 be relocated to a site west of its current location and that the approach be constructed for its intersection with State Route 73 with the addition of a traffic signal light which shall be installed, and with the tribe bearing a percentage of the cost of the light and with the tribe agreeing to maintain the light and provide electricity.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the relocation of Indian Route 55 as to the location described in the drawings presented by the Tribal Engineering Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves the installation of a traffic signal light at the intersection of IR 55 and State Route 73 in Whiteriver.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council agrees that the White Mountain Apache Tribe shall bear its proportionate share of the installation cost for the traffic light signal and will bear maintenance and electricity cost.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to take any actions necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on June 9, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and TWO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (b) & (h) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29,

1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
