

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Athletic Department Director and two representatives of the Alchesay High School Football Team appeared before the Tribal Council for the purpose of requesting assistance so that the boys on the football team might attend camp; and

WHEREAS, the financial support requested amounts to \$50.00 per student for approximately 60 students for a total amount of \$3,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council desires to be of assistance to these young people; and

WHEREAS, the Land Claims General Fund has money available for such a project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby sets aside \$3,000.00 for the Alchesay High School Football students to attend camp at Sunrise; such amount to be distributed at \$50.00 per student.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that this payment shall be coordinated through Lloyd Susan, the Treasurer, and Dallas Massey of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
