

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Darrell Parker and family have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter, Cheryl Parker during the weekend of August 12 and 13, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd Antonio have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Darrell and Cynthia (Lupe) Parker, Sponsors, and Lloyd and Charlotte (Johnson) Antonio, Godparents to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of August 12 and 13, 1989, at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f), (g), and (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
