
WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Cato Sell Traux have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Cibecue.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. and Mrs. Jonas Dehose, Sponsors, and Mr. and Mrs. Cato Sell Truax, Godparents to hold a Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week of August 19 and 20, 1989.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f), (g), and (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
