


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Dr. Donald Marianos, a dentist at the Indian Health Service who has served the White Mountain Apache Tribe and it's members for eleven years has been reassigned to a station in Atlanta, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes that Dr. Marianos has honorably given of his time and service to the White Mountain Apache people and the absence of his services will be a loss to the Apache people.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby expresses its appreciation to Dr. Donald Marianos, of the Indian Health Service for his years of honorable and dedicated service to the White Mountain Apache people and expresses its best wishes to him in his new endeavors.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
