

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Director Rubert Lupe of the Vocational Skill Center has requested that the revenue generated from 1988/89 service contract with the State of Arizona DES Rehabilitation Services Administration be used to operate the Handicap Vocational Training Program at the Vocational Skill Center; and

WHEREAS, and there is a need through this program to provide services to handicap tribal members; and

WHEREAS, Rubert Lupe has assured that the Tribal Council that there will be no tribal funds involved in the proposal.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Vocational Skill Center Director Rubert Lupe is hereby authorized to accept and utilize the revenue generated from 1988/89 Service Contract with the State of Arizona DES Rehabilitation Services Administration for the purposes of operating the tribes handicap vocational training program at the Skill Center.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1989 duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a,j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


