RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that there are contaminated materials in the old abandon hospital building and at the old sawmill at McNary and at Apache Manufacturing Company; and

WHEREAS, the removal of said contaminated materials is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and its members.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the Indian Health Service are hereby requested to remove hazardous waste materials from the old hospital, the sawmill and AMCO as soon as possible.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority bested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
