

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Navajo Nation Archaeological Department applied to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a permit to conduct a archaeological inventory of the homesite track in Northfork belonging to Gabriel C. Ethelbah; and
- WHEREAS, the said homesite track is an approved land assignment to Gabriel and Dephine Ethelbah; and
- WHEREAS, the archaeological inventory is for a purpose of clearing the land so that the Ethelbah's might have a home built for them by the Navajo and Hopi Indian Relocation Commission; and
- WHEREAS, it is the best interest of the Tribal member that said archaeological inventory be permitted.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Navajo Nation Archaeological Department is hereby granted a permit from the White Mountain Apache Tribe to conduct a archaeological inventory of the homesite in Northfork belonging to Gabriel C. and Dephine Ethelbah.


