FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Stanley and Rosalita (Henry) White, parents of Rolanda Kay White have requested the Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter during the Thanksgiving Holidays, of November 22, 23, 24, 25 and 26, 1989; and


WHEREAS, Benny and Rosalita (Walker) Lupe, have been chosen as Godparents and have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Stanley and Rosalita (Henry) White, Sponsors, and Benny and Rosalita (Walker) Lupe (Godparents) to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Rolanda Kay White during the Thanksgiving Holiday of November 22, 23, 24, 25 and 26, 1989 in Whiteriver at the old fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on November 1, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) (g) & (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
