

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Theresa Moody, a tribal member and employee of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, has come before the Tribal Council pursuant to Section 13.5 of the Tribal Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual to appeal the decision of the Tribal Chairman and the Tribal Grievance Committee arising out of certain disciplinary actions taken against her as an employee of the White Mountain Apache Tribe by the Department of Social Services; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has agreed to hear the matter of Ms. Moody's appeal and to render a decision; and

WHEREAS, among other things Ms. Moody is requesting back pay arising out of her demotion from a position having a higher pay grade to a position having a lower pay grade; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after considerable discussion, has concluded that Ms. Moody should be awarded back pay but that she should not be reinstated to her former position, but that she should be considered for promotion at such time as in the opinion of the Director of the Tribal Social Services Department, Ms. Moody is capable of returning to a position of comparable responsibilities to that which she formerly held.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Department of Social Services to make arrangements as quickly as is possible to pay to Ms. Moody the requested back pay in the amount of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Six (\$3,846.00) Dollars. This effort will be coordinated with the Bureau of Indian Affairs who will determine if carry-over funds are available to meet this expense of the Tribal Social Services Department.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman may take whatever actions he deems necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 1989, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
