

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Seven Mile Logging Unit is included in the five year timber program; and

WHEREAS, a three year contract has been prepared without a formal appraisal; and

WHEREAS, a formal appraisal will be prepared annually during the Fort Apache Timber Company reappraisal; and

WHEREAS, the Seven Mile sale package has been reviewed by the Interdisciplinary Team and the Forestry Committee and approval has been recommended by the Forestry Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Seven Mile Timber Sale includes seven road construction and reconstruction projects totalling 3.0 miles as follows:

Road #1	.9 mile	to access virgin area
Road #4	.9 mile	to access virgin area
Road #6	.3 mile	to access virgin area
Road #7	.1 mile	to avoid unsafe (20%) road grade
Road #8	.4 mile	to avoid unsafe (26%) road grade
Road #9	.1 mile	to avoid a spring
Road #10	.2 mile	to avoid stream and reduce road grade; and

WHEREAS, these road proposals have been reviewed by the Interdisciplinary Team and the Forestry committee and approval has been recommended by the Forestry Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Seven Mile Logging Unit, including the above mentioned seven road projects, as presented in the proposed contract for the sale of timber, and subject to minor changes and administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer, be sold to the Fort Apache Timber Company as described below:



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council or his representative is authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of timber for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.-984).
