

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe heard the facts surrounding the case of Rick Daniels site survey for Project AZ 16-45; and
- WHEREAS, Rick Daniels first site was rejected due to archeological findings; and
- WHEREAS, Rick Daniels has exercised his right not to live in a designated housing project area at Fort Apache, but requests that his second site be surveyed; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council considers Rick Daniels request reasonable under the circumstances and supports Rick Daniels request.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a request is made to the Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of Indian Programs, to survey Rick Daniels second site at North Diamond Creek.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


