

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member Beverly Malone has come before the Tribal Council to request authorization and assistance in having a road put into their homesite area; and

WHEREAS, the Councilmembers from the area have agreed to coordinate this activity with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that authorization to put in a road to the Malone homesite area is hereby given; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Councilmembers representing the area are hereby directed to coordinate this task and to work with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to accomplish it.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (m) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984)
