

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Dr. Jeff Reid of the University of Arizona Archaeology Department has requested that the Tribal Council grant permission to him and the University of Arizona to conduct the 1990 Summer Field School at Grasshopper; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Reid has conducted the Summer Field School at Grasshopper for many years in a manner satisfactory to the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Dr. Reid's study should be allowed to continue.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Dr. Jeff Reid and the University of Arizona to conduct the 1990 Summer Field School at Grasshopper.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Dr. Reid to coordinate with Phillip Stago, Jr. of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Game and Fish Enterprise, and Edgar Perry of the Tribal Museum, including a meeting with said persons at the beginning of the Project and a closing meeting at the end of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council states that any artifacts, objects, etc. discovered during the study are the property of the Tribe, and if needed to be removed from the reservation, are merely on loan for study purposes; an inventory of such items shall be provided to the Tribal Game and Fish Department and the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
