RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Safety Director has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the unsafe condition of the old kiln building at McNary; and
- WHEREAS, the Safety Director recommends that the old kiln building be dismantled;
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the Safety Director to make the arrangements for and the demolition of the old kiln building at McNary;

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 22, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven for and zero against</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
