

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Ramon Riley, Director of the Tribal Labor Relations Department, has come before the Tribal Council to inform them that a seat on the Hearing Board of Commissioners was recently vacated due to the resignation of Council member, Nelson Ethelbah; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Reagan Armstrong is experienced in the construction business, and therefore, it is requested that Mr. Armstrong be appointed as a member of the Hearing Board of Commissioners to fill the vacancy created by Nelson Ethelbah's resignation; and
- WHEREAS, the current membership of the Hearing Board of Commissioners consists of three members, and due to the expected increase in construction activities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation beginning in the spring of 1990, a need exists to increase the Board membership; and
- WHEREAS, the membership of the Hearing Board of Commissioners should be increased to five (5) members in order to better serve the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Riley has presented the following names of individuals who are experienced and knowledgeable in the areas of construction and labor relation laws, for consideration in filling the two new positions on the Hearing Board:

1. Marvin Brawley
2. Debbie Wapaha

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Reagan Armstrong to the position on the Hearing Board of Commissioners which was recently vacated by Nelson Ethelbah; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the increase in the membership of the Hearing Board of Commissioners from the present three members, to five members; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Marvin Brawley and Debbie Wapaha are hereby appointed to fill the two new positions resulting from the increase in membership of the Hearing Board of Commissioners.

The foregoing resolution was on March 14, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
