


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Acting Superintendent of the Bureau of Indian Affairs that a resolution of the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is needed in order to honor the request of the Chairman that five Bureau of Indian Affairs trailers located in Cibecue scheduled for demolition instead be turned over to the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and it's members that useable buildings such as these be turned over to the Tribe rather than demolished;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby joins in the request of the Chairman to the Bureau of Indian Affairs that the five trailers located at Cibecue scheduled for demolition be turned over to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for their use;

The foregoing resolution was on March 22, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (c), (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958. pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).

Dear Mr. Johnson:

As per action of the Agency Board of Survey on October 4, 1988, and as amended on March 22, 1990, in accordance with 42 BIAM Supplement 2,114H-47.7501, a determination has been made that five mobile homes, located on the Cibecue School have been declared excess to the needs of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The five mobile homes may be conveyed to the White Mountain Apache Tribe upon passage of a resolution in accordance with 25 U.S.C. 443a and 42 BIAM Supplement 2,114H-47.7501-1, the mobile homes are to be conveyed in an "as is" condition with no outlay of federal funds in their repair.

Upon receipt of your tribal resolution a conveyance document will be prepared.
