

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Pauline Platt has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the fact that no progress has been made on the request to rebuild her house which activity was assigned to Ronnie Lupe, Lafe Altaha, and Matthew Nozie along with Dallas Massey of the Bureau of Indian Affairs on February 14, 1990 by Resolution No. 02-90-28; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council on September 13, 1989, was advised by David Gloshey a need to renovate his HIP home which burned in a fire; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Nelson Ethelbah was directed to notify Mr. Rupert Lupe from the Vocational Skill Center to obtain an estimate for the cost of such a renovation; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 09-89-213, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe directed Rupert Lupe to make arrangements to renovate bathroom facilities of Tribal Member David Gordon for the purpose of providing handicapped facilities;


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the persons above named to coordinate and conduct activities to provide adequate and decent housing for Pauline Platt, David Gordon and David Gloshey as previously directed by the Tribal Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe expects that said housing will be provided through coordination and donation from all appropriate agencies including but not limited to the Weatherization Program, FATCO, Indian Health Services and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
