

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that Mildred Bonito, a 60 year old tribal member has been seeking housing for seven years; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to support Ms. Bonito in her request for housing; and

WHEREAS, the HIP Program has had Ms. Bonito's application before it for some time; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it to be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the tribal members be afforded adequate decent housing.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recommends that the HIP Housing Program considers Ms. Mildred Bonito as a recipient for a HIP house and recommends that she be given housing in the Whiteriver area.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
