RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Alvin Declay, Athletic Director has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the need for repairs on the fencing surrounding the Seven-Mile Community Building; and
- WHEREAS, in addition to the fencing the Seven-Mile Community outdoor facilities are in need of proper lighting; and
- WHEREAS, with the upcoming summer months it is important that said repairs and maintenance be given attention before the heavy summer use of the facilities begins.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Director of the Athletic Department, Mr. Alvin Declay is hereby given authority to seek bids to ascertain the approximate cost for the renovation of the fence and the installation of proper lighting at the Seven-Mile Community Building.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
