

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Andrew and Lucy (Sanchez) Yazzie and family have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of July 13-15, 1990; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Lela Mae Cosen has been chosen as Godparent and she has accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old fairgrounds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Andrew and Lucy (Sanchez) Yazzie Sponsor, and Ms. Lela Mae Cosen, Godparent, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week of July 13-15, 1990, at the old fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
