

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Leonard Fall has requested permission to sponsor a Memorial Rodeo and dance, August 10-12, 1990, in memory of his only son Leander, who passed away last July, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fall requests that the Memorial Hall or Exhibit Hall be made available to him for the dance and that he be allowed to use the new fairgrounds for the rodeo; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council advises Mr. Fall to contact the Fair Commission regarding the use of the Exhibit Hall and the Director of the Tribal Athletic Department for use of the Memorial Hall so that he can make a decision as to which facility he may utilize.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Mr. Leonard Fall to sponsor a Memorial Rodeo and Dance in memory of his son, Leander on August 10, 11, and 12, 1990 at the new fairgrounds, and either the Memorial Hall or Exhibit Hall, which ever is available through the Tribal Fair and Rodeo Commission and Whiteriver Athletic Department.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 1990 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
