## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member, Vernon Palmer, has requested Tribal Council approval to purchase a Hondah Homesite home from any person willing to sell to him at the area known as Hondah homesite; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there is no policy or legal objection to granting said approval.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval to tribal member, Vernon Palmer, to purchase a home at his own expense and pursuant to his own financial arrangements from any person willing to sell to him in what is known as the Hondah Homesite Development Area.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 13, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
