

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is faced with an unprecedented cash flow crisis; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has initiated measures for reduction in force including recommendations and requirements that certain departments shut down for two weeks and that in addition the essential departments reduce their expenditures by 50% either by reduction in force or reducing expenditures; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council appreciates the sacrifices that Tribal Departments and employees have made to help remedy the cash crisis; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to express its appreciation and support by likewise reducing Tribal Council pay for meetings from \$125.00 to \$75.00 per diem while in session.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that effective immediately the Tribal Council pay while in session will be reduced to \$75.00 per diem per member.

The foregoing resolution was on June 20, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984)
