## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has contracted with the Department of Economic Security since 1982 for services to the elderly and handicapped; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has submitted a proposal for FY 90-91 (July 1, 1990 June 30, 1991) for Advocacy, Home Care and Home Delivered Meals for such services with the Department of Economic Security; and
- WHEREAS, the aforementioned programs have always been in good standing with the Department of Economic Security, Aging and Adult Administration; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received information that the signing of Department of Economic Security contracts have been delayed, but will be retroactive July 1, 1990.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Title XX Programs to incur normal operating costs until such time that the signed contracts are returned not to exceed 30 days.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
