

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe will benefit if members of the Tribal Council are able to devote themselves fulltime to their responsibilities of identifying community problems and recommending legislative solutions thereto and to otherwise fulfill their responsibilities set forth in the Tribal Constitution to protect the health, education, welfare and safety of tribal members and property; and

WHEREAS, the duties and responsibilities of the Tribal Council may best be served by placing Tribal Council Members on full-time Council pay so that Council Members may devote fulltime to their legislative and community responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Tribal Council member Frank Johnny Endfield, Jr. should receive Council compensation in the amount of \$20,900.00 per annum.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby places Council Member Frank Johnny Endfield, Jr. on a full-time council status with compensation of \$20,900.00, this resolution to be effective July 23, 1990.

The foregoing resolution was on July 12, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) (s) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
