

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member Mabel (Palmer) Kasey of Canyon Day has requested housing assistance from the Tribal Council; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Mrs. Kasey and her husband live in a home in grave need of repair, that she does not have adequate cooking facilities indoors and must do here cooking outside the home and that her only shelter from the rain and other elements in her and her husband's bedroom is a tarp for a roof and that the general condition of the home is very poor and hardly suitable as a residence; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes based upon these observations as confirmed by Tribal Council Members that Mabel (Palmer) Kasey and her husband should be placed on the priority list under the Housing Improvement Program (H.I.P.).

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Director of the Housing Improvement Program to place Mabel (Palmer) Kasey and her husband on the priority list for housing.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
