

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Game and Fish Department is responsible for developing and implementing non-tribal member hunting regulations on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and


WHEREAS, the Game and Fish Department has reviewed the previous years' regulations and analyzed hunting and game population data, and has developed and presented recommendations for the 1990-91 non-tribal member hunting season; and

WHEREAS, the Department is once again proposing a "special non-tribal member affiliated cow hunt" in order to achieve elk population and harvest objectives for the reservation elk herd.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has reviewed and considered the proposed 1990-91 non-tribal member hunting regulations and hereby approves the regulations as presented, including the proposed affiliated non-tribal member cow hunt.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
