

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Council Member Judy Dehose of the Cibecue Community advises the Tribal Council that the Cibecue Community Board of Education passed a Board resolution requesting that the Bureau of Indian Affairs assign Theresa Susan, a tribal member and also a teacher at the J.F.K. BIA School in Cedar Creek, to the Cibecue Community School as a teacher for the proposed pre-first grade program which would involve approximately fifty (50) children who are too advanced for kindergarten but not quite ready for first grade; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Theresa Susan is a tribal member, fluent in Apache and is a certified teacher and that the School Board is requesting that Mrs. Susan's transfer to the Cibecue Community School be pursuant to an IPA Assignment with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and that the Tribal Council support the School Board's request; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby agrees to support the School Board's request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs enter into an IPA Assignment to allow Mrs. Theresa Susan, presently a certified teacher at the J.F.K. BIA school in Cedar Creek to be assigned to the Cibecue Community School as a teacher for the proposed pre-first grade program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman or his authorized representative to enter into any and all agreements necessary to implement this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 28, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (b) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).


