

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised by Tribal Council Member, Judy Dehose, that the Cibecue Community School Board is requesting permission from the Tribal Council to participate in the Federal and State of Arizona Surplus Property Donation Program in order to obtain surplus property from the Federal and State Surplus Program for use at the Cibecue Community School; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Federal and State of Arizona Surplus Program provides an opportunity for the school to obtain much needed property for its classrooms and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Cibecue Community School Board should be granted permission to participate in Federal and State of Arizona Surplus Property Donation Programs.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Cibecue Community School Board, acting on behalf of the Cibecue Community School, permission to participate in the Federal and State of Arizona Surplus Property Donation Programs in order to enable the school to obtain surplus property from said programs.


The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
