RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has received a a petition from concerned parents and members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that land claims monies set aside in the IIM Land Claims General Recreation Fund Account be utilized to help in the financing of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Headstart Program; and
- WHEREAS, the specific request has been for \$48,000 to assist fifty-one (51) students; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that presently there is \$105,860.22 in the Docket 22-D Recreation fund account; and
- WHEREAS, said monies represent the balance remaining in a fund pursuant to a Plan for the Use and Distribution of Western Apache Judgment Funds awarded in Docket 22-D before the Indian Claims Commission; and
- WHEREAS, it us further recommended by motion from a councilmember that the balance of the \$105,860.22 be given to the White Mountain Apache Education Department in order to provide financial assistance to college students; and
- WHEREAS, after lengthy discussion the Tribal Council agrees to grant the request of the petitioners for \$48,000 as well as the recommendation that the balance of the Recreation Fund be given to the Tribal Education Department to financially assist college students.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes \$48,000 from the IIM Land Claim General Recreation Funds Account to be given to the White Mountain Apache Headstart Program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes and directs that the balance of the monies in the Land Claims General Recreation Fund Account be tendered to the White Mountain Apache Education Department for the purpose of providing financial assistance to college students.

The foregoing resolution was on October 3, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
