

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Randall Massey, Jr., Councilman from District III, has come before the Tribal Council and advised that the East Fork Community is in need of a public telephone centrally located because the only public phone available is inside the East Fork Trading Post, which closes at 6:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Massey suggests that the telephone booth be installed in front of Leslie Walker's residence in East Fork, which would provide a centralized location for said booth; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Massey's request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the request of Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr., to install a public telephone booth in front of Leslie Walker's residence in the East Fork Community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that the Continental Telephone Company grant this request and install a public telephone booth at the location described herein, and that Mr. Massey is authorized, pursuant to this Resolution, to meet with Contel officials for the purpose of locating said telephone booth.

The foregoing resolution was on October 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
