

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr. has come before the Tribal Council and requested that \$5,000 from the General Recreation Fund, established pursuant to the land claims judgement in Docket 22-D, be utilized to improve the Turkey Creek Rodeo Grounds and that any balance remaining after said improvements be utilized to upgrade the little league field adjacent to the rodeo grounds; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Massey advises the Tribal Council that since General Recreation funds will be utilized to improve the Turkey Creek Rodeo grounds and little league field, that the rodeo grounds will be available for reservation-wide use; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$5,000 from Judgement Docket 22-D, General Recreation funds, for the purpose of improving the Turkey Creek Rodeo grounds, with any balance remaining of the \$5,000 after improvements are completed on the rodeo grounds, to be utilized for improvement and upgrade of the adjacent little league baseball field.

The foregoing resolution was on October 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
