

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, District IV Councilmember Johnny Endfield has requested through the Office of the Tribal Chairman, land claim monies designated for Whiteriver and Diamond Creek Communities in the amount of \$23,959.00 as itemized in the attached list of equipment for the purpose of establishing a television translator system for Over-the-Rainbow/Diamond Creek and North Fork Area communities; and

WHEREAS, after Tribal Council discussion the Council concludes that Mr. Endfield should be directed to obtain signatures in the form of a petition from the communities named above prior to the release of land claim funds to purchase cable television equipment; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that authorization should be granted for the release of North Fork, Rainbow, and Diamond Creek land claims monies to purchase the equipment contingent upon receipt by the Office of the Tribal Chairman of petitions from the communities of Over-the-Rainbow/Diamond Creek/North Fork Area requesting that these funds be released for said purpose.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$23,959.00 for the purchase of a television translator system for Over-the-Rainbow, Diamond Creek and North Fork Area communities contingent upon Councilmember Johnny Endfield obtaining required number of signatures in the form of petitions from the forenamed communities requesting that their land claim monies be utilized for the proposed television translator system.

The foregoing resolution was on October 16, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h), (i), and (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
