

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has traditionally purchased Christmas Candy with General Tribal Land Claims funds for distribution in each District on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that the 1990 Christmas Candy Distribution be made as follows:


WHEREAS the total cost for 10,700 sacks of Christmas Candy is \$14,700 to be paid for by General Tribal Land Claim Funds; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the use of \$14,700 of General Tribal Land Claim Funds for the purchase of 10,700 sacks of Christmas Candy to be distributed in accordance with this Resolution

The foregoing resolution was on November 29, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
