## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Kino Kane has requested assistance from the Tribal Council for tribal member Dorothy Ethelbah, a tribal elder who resides in Cedar Creek and who is presently undergoing kidney dialysis; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Kino Kane explains to the Council that Dorothy Ethelbah is in need of transportation to Show Low for dialysis treatment and no transportation is available from family members; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Kane requests that the Council authorize the office of the Chairman to inquire into transportation from CHR or some other assistance that might be available.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Office of the Tribal Chairman to assist tribal member Dorothy Ethelbah in locating transportation so that she can obtain the dialysis treatment necessary for her health and well-being.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 13, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
