RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council on March 14, 1990, passed Resolution No. 03-90-54 placing tribal member Debra Baha-Alchesay on the HIP Housing List; and
- WHEREAS, when Ms. Alchesay was placed on the list, she met all eligibility qualifications for the HIP Program; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Alchesay has come before the Tribal Council and has advised that she was told she was ineligible because she is now working for the Tribe
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that once Ms. Alchesay was eligible, she should remain eligible and remain on the list of qualified applicants for HIP Housing.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 03-90-54 passed on March 14, 1990, stating that Debra Baha-Alchesay is eligible for HIP Housing.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 9, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>EIGHT</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) (k) and (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
