RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Doreen White from East Fork, a young mother with a child, has come before the Tribal Council and requested Tribal Council assistance in placing her on the HIP Housing Priority List; and
- WHEREAS, she advises the Tribal Council that the house she lived in burned to the ground and she has been living in various places and is in great need of a home for herself and her child; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. White explains that she is presently unemployed; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that based upon her circumstances, Ms. White should be placed on the HIP Housing Priority List.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby places Ms. Doreen White of East Fork on the HIP Housing Priority List.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 9, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
