## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerned council members, and citizens that an inventory of housing needs on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is long overdue and must be completed in order to qualify the White Mountain Apache Tribe for future and additional funding; and
- WHEREAS, failure on the part of the Tribe to complete a housing need inventory may directly impact on availability of HIP Housing for eligible tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, previously, the Job Training Partnership Act Office of the White Mountain Apache Tribe supervised the HIP Program on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, JTPA, in partnership and cooperation with the Tribal Vocational Skill Center, has qualified personnel knowledgeable in the construction crafts who can properly conduct a housing need inventory and survey on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that due to the imperative need to complete a housing need inventory, it would be in the best interest of the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby places the HIP Program under the supervision of JTPA.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby places the HIP Program under the supervision of JTPA.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs JTPA in cooperation with the Vocational Skill Center to conduct an immediate and comprehensive housing need inventory in accordance with HIP Regulations and Procedures and to provide a written report of its findings to the Tribal Council at the regular February 1991 Tribal Council meeting.

## Resolution No. 01-91-19

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
