## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by Resolution No. 01-91-11, gave final approval to Ordinance No. 166 amending Section 2.3 of the Criminal Code providing that any assault upon a Tribal Councilmember while in session or in the conduct of Tribal Council Business would constitute a criminal offense; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has advised that the resolution was not delivered to the Bureau within the 10 days as required by the Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to reaffirm final approval of Ordinance No. 166 amending Section 2.3 of the Criminal Code this date.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms it's final approval of Ordinance No. 166 amending Section 2.3 of the Criminal Code, in the form and content attached to prior Resolution No. 01-91-11, passed on January 9, 1991.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 25, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (q) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
