## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, pursuant to prior Tribal Council Resolution No. 01-91-12, the Tribal Council directed that the Tribal Council Secretary post a proposed "Good Samaritan" Ordinance No. 167; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that said proposed ordinance was posted in accordance with the requirements of the Tribal Constitution for a period of at least ten days in each district for purposes of obtaining public comment; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that proposed Emergency Aid Ordinance No. 167, amending the Health and Safety Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be enacted this date.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts the Emergency Aid Ordinance No. 167, amending the White Mountain Apache Health and Safety Code effective this date.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (q) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
