RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the delivery of human services to the elderly and to persons with various disabilities is a priority of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Elderly and disabled persons have difficulty in accessing such services because of lack of available transportation; and
- WHEREAS, the elders that reside in the Cedar Creek and Carrizo Community suffer additional difficulties due to the isolation of the area; and
- WHEREAS, the Central Arizona Council of Government through the Arizona Department of Transportation is in the process of receiving proposals for vehicles to address the needs of the elderly and the handicapped in Gila County.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby requests funding from the Central
 Arizona Council of Government for one such vehicle and
 hereby supports the submission of the proposal by
 Tribal Elderly Services as set forth herein.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
